<sup>1</sup> New Hampshire statute: ""The owners of adjoining lands are allowed to build and maintain a partition fence between their properties in equal shares. If two adjoining property owners do not agree on a division or a division has not been established by usage and acquiescence by means of the earlier installation of a fence, the Fence Viewers are called in establish a division. Fence viewers are without power to settle controversies in respect to disputed boundary lines and have no power to make a division of fences except upon the true line. They are also called upon to assign fence maintenance responsibilities to adjoining property owners."
